These state, regional and national awards in composition are classified by age and have first, second and third place monetary awards. The deadline for application is February 1 to our state chairman.

Biennial Junior Awards

include: Claire Ulrich Whitehurst Piano Award given in piano solo to a high school student with a \$500 first place award, application deadline is March 1 (even years.) Lynn Freeman Olson Composition Awards are given to those in grades 7 – 12 with a March 1 deadline for applications (odd numbered years.) The Thelma Robinson Award in Ballet is given to those between the

ages of 13 – 19 with a deadline of October 1 (even numbered years.) See the NFMC website for more information and entry forms.

Annual Junior Awards

This includes those previously mentioned along with named awards in vocal, piano, piano concerto, brass instrumental and orchestral instruments, ballet and theater dance, cello or double bass, poetry, essay, composition and viola. Award age categories vary as well as the amounts of the awards. The awards have different deadlines and chairmen. Please see the NFMC website for more detailed information as well as entry forms.

State Chairmen

Some of the Junior awards have state chairmen who eagerly await your application. The WFMC Directory will be updated and distributed (via email) soon. Check to see if an award has a state chairman so that you may contact them with your application and information. It is no longer possible to have chairman for each and every award and program (there are close to 90) so contact your state president if a chairman is

not listed for help in navigating the award charts.

Awards that are particular to our state are: Apple for the Teacher, Ruth Krueser Scholarships, Senior Club Grants, and our State Festival Competition which has scholarship opportunities available in performance.

This Newsletter is a reminder that students from our state do very well on a regional and national level in a variety of awards, competitions, and programs. Enter your students to take advantage of awards that are funded by fellow members of Music Clubs.
