LIABILITY INSURANCE 2018-19 IS COMING DUE

Reminders have been sent but here is one more! Time to send in information and \$17 per event in order to insure your events, concerts, meetings, festivals and other programs that may be conducted, organized, and/or sponsored by a senior or junior club, or studio. **Insurance for any and all music club events is a must.**

Any coordinator of a Federation Festival is required to submit information on the festival (date, place, address) but the fee for WFMC Festivals is covered by the WFMC. The fee is only waived for the WFMC Federation Festivals.

Attached are the forms you need in order to contact Susan Daniels, WFMC Treasurer, with your event data. All NFMC states use this general liability coverage insurance. *This is liability coverage only.*

A person responsible for the music club event, concert, recital, meeting etc. needs to sign a **Child Protection Form**. This may include you, or your club, as a member of the WFMC. *There are no exceptions as this is an insurance company requirement nationwide.*

If you do not have 2018-19 dates set – don't panic as dates can be added later. You will be signing the Child Protection Forms to correspond to what you are insuring and this paperwork can be submitted now along with your \$17 per event being insured. (\$18 for late submissions, \$20 for events with consecutive days.)

Deadlines for 2018 – 2019 are as noted previously:

August 1 for events September 1 to December 31, 2018

November 15 for events, January 1 – August 31, 2019

Information from Susan:

The Liability Request Form needs to be filled out in complete and full detail with specific address and email contact information (if applicable.) Indicate if your event requires a *certificate of insurance* and any other specific information that may be required by the facility. The certificate will be forwarded to the contact person listed on this form. If the certificate must be sent directly to the facility, please provide that contact information.

The Child Protection Form is for all coordinators of a festival or music club event or anyone who is a member in charge of a music club sponsored event, you must sign this form published by the CDC.
