Junior Composers Summer Programs 2019

Our North Central Region sponsors a composer's camp for youth ages 14-20 who want to take their composition skills to the next level. We are a proud part of the National Federation of Music Clubs Summer Camp Programs.

Theme for 2019 **Strings + Piano**

Three camp experiences are offered to meet the needs of exceptional composition students and what they hope to strive for, dream for, and achieve. Skilled and dedicated faculty, staff, guest artists, readings of pieces with guest professional musicians, along with a premiere of student compositions are offered again this summer!

Studio (two weeks) July 8 – 20

Concentrated instruction to take compositions to the next level.

- *Guest Composer in-residence, master classes
- *Score analysis
- *Composition tutorials
- *Advanced notation software help
- *Premiere of an original song at the Salon
- *Workshops with guest artists
- *Field trips
- *Music theory/ear training
- *Expectation to compose two works while at camp

Cost: \$2100 with a non-refundable deposit of \$200 due at the time of your on-line registration.

This camp is limited to 20 students.

Songwriters (one week) July 14 - 20

Specifically, for students interested in pop music genres, Eric Radloff songwriter in-residence.

- *Daily salons with professional artists/songwriters
- *Writing lyrics
- *Planning chord charts
- *Learn how to write for instruments
- *Writing/pro recording of an original song while at camp
- *Premiere of an original song at the Salon

Cost: \$1150 with a non-refundable deposit of \$100 due at the time of your on-line registration.

This camp is limited to 20 students.

Institute (one week) July 14 – 20

The original, since 2002, JCSP camp!

- *Two hours of daily music theory/ear training
- *Compose and perform new compositions
- *Field trips
- *Daily salons with guest artists
- *minimum of three private lessons

Cost: \$1100 with a non-refundable deposit of \$100 due at the time of your on-line registration.

This camp is limited to 20 students.

Your student could be part of an exciting composition journey with other students from across the country. All classes are at the University of Minnesota, School of Music. Tuition cost includes room and board at the University of Minnesota along with a meal program. Rooms and the meal venue (Middlebrook Hall) are a short walking distance to the School of Music.

Special Opportunity – Students registered for the 2019 summer sessions are invited to compose a piece for a string and piano ensemble. These pieces should be 2-4 minutes in length and should be submitted electronically to Seth Custer at: sacuster@hotmail.com no later than June 10, 2019.
